

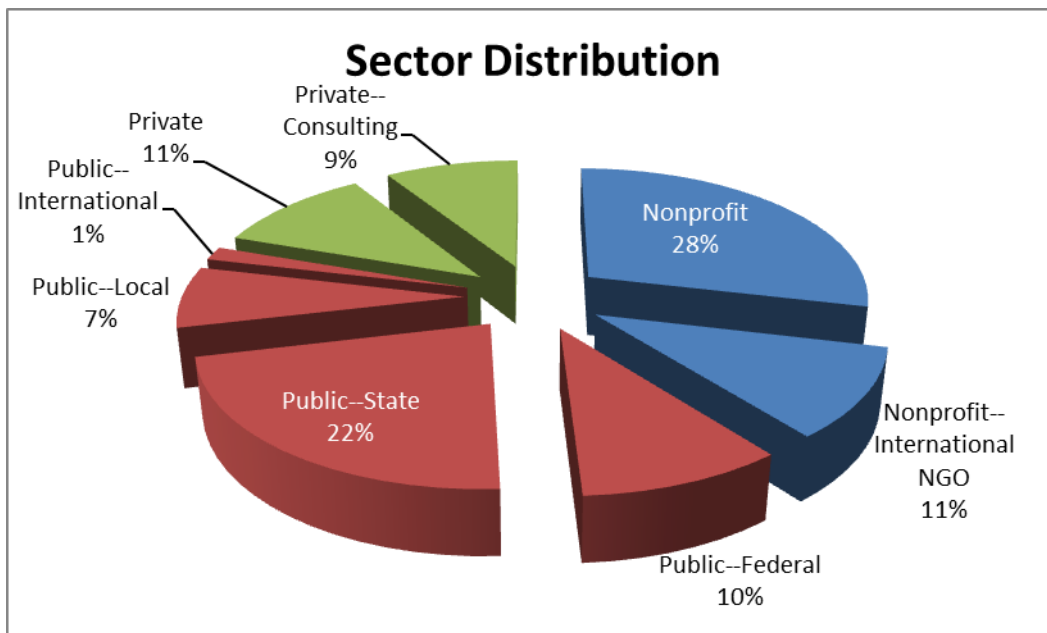


Class of 2011 Master of Public Administration (MPA) Employment Report

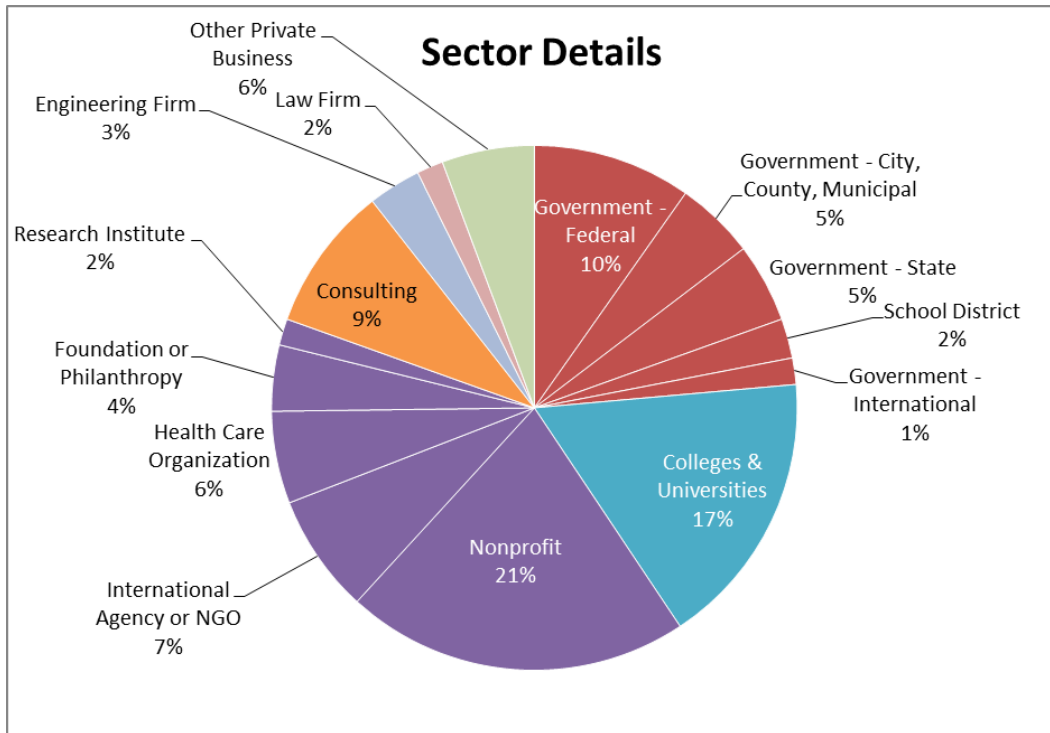
Class of 2011 graduates* surveyed upon graduation and again six months later. Surveys were sent via email, with three reminders to non-responders. Compiled 12/30/11.

- Response rate: 86%

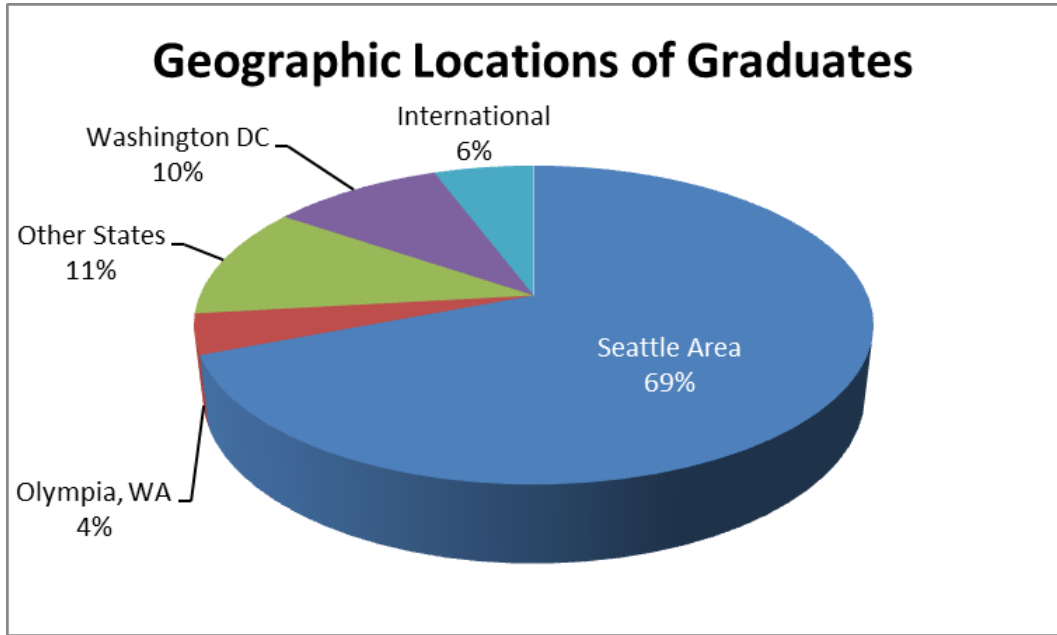
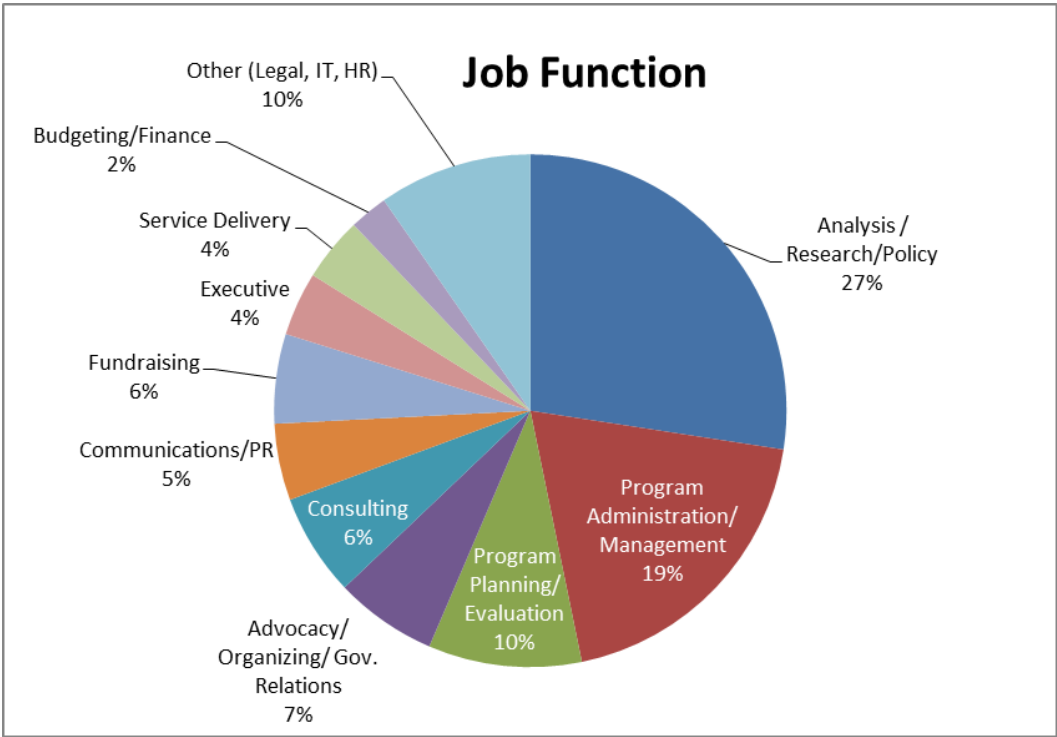

2011 MPA Salaries

A total of 66 graduates reported the salaries of their positions; international salaries were excluded. The overall average salary was \$49,705; the low was \$30,000, the high was \$90,000, and the median was \$46,000.

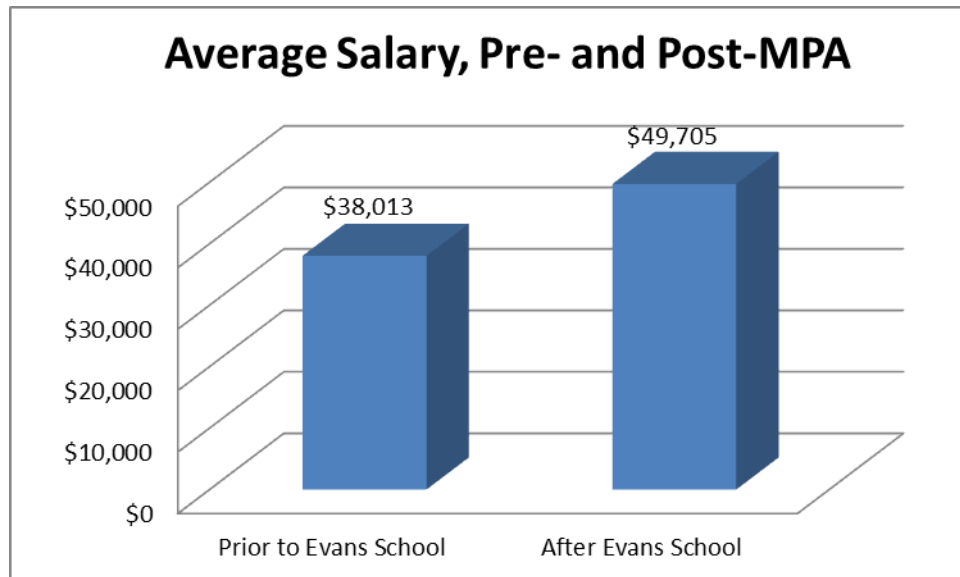

Reported Salary Increase After Graduation

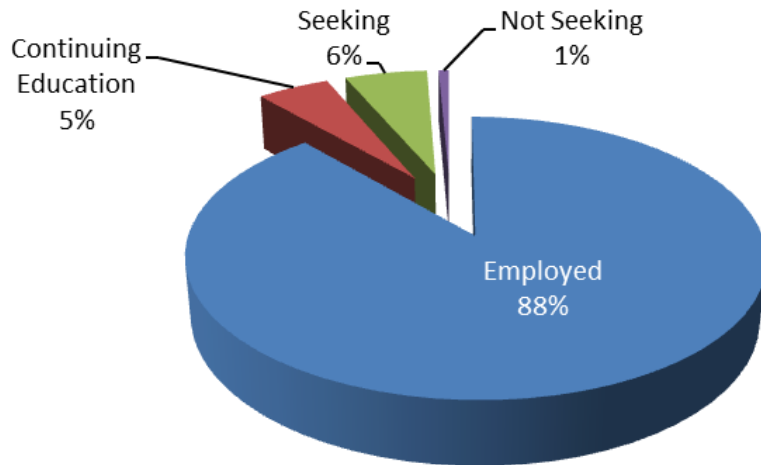
66 graduates who obtained employment responded with information about their pre- and post-MPA salary. International stipends/salaries were not included. Of students who reported both pre- and post-graduate salary, 74% received an increase in salary, others did not earn an increase but made a major career change, typically from the private sector to government or nonprofit.

Average increase in salary (of students reporting an increase): **\$18,907**

Average percentage increase: **52%**

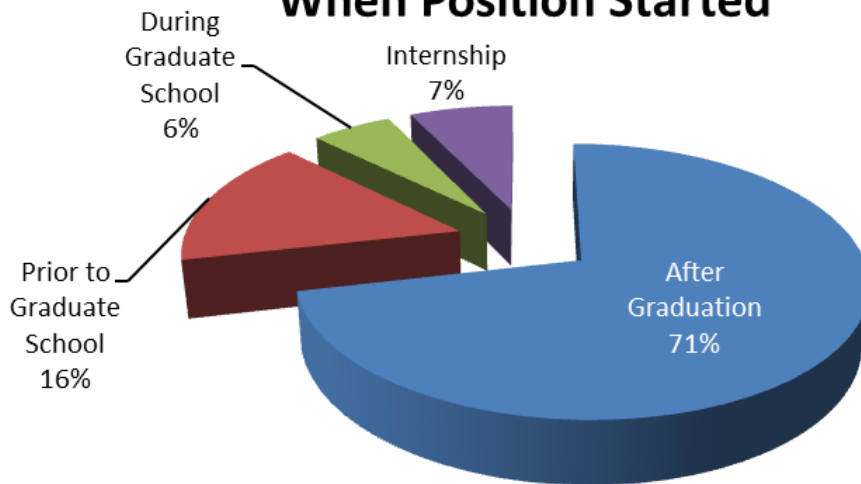


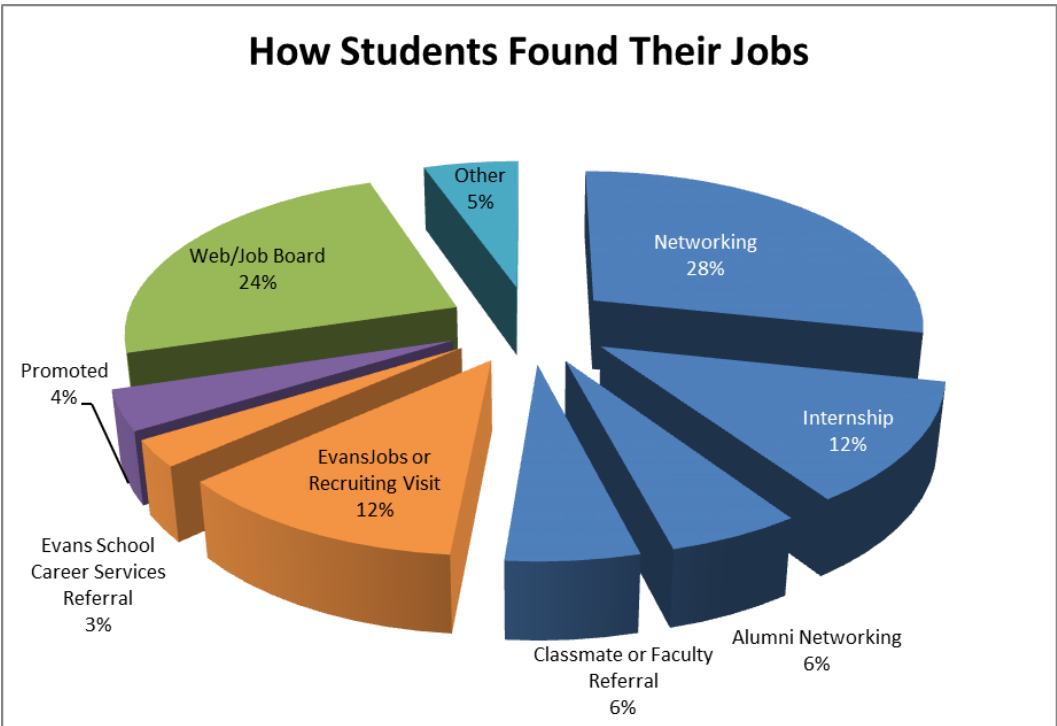
Status 6 Months Post Graduation

40% of Evans School students found their jobs through networking (including introductions to alumni made through Career Services or the Evans School LinkedIn group); 27% found positions through Career Services directly or through their internships; and 24% found positions through a general job board.
