The Hubert H. Humphrey Fellowship Program provides a year of professional enrichment in the United States for experienced professionals from designated countries throughout the world. Fellows are selected based on their potential for leadership and their commitment to public service in either the public or private sector.

The Humphrey Program fosters a mutual exchange of knowledge and understanding about issues of common concern in the United States and the Fellows' home countries. Each year approximately 200 Fellows funded by the Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs of the U.S. Department of State engage in non-degree study and related professional experiences at selected American universities. Started in 1978, the program now has a network of over 4,400 alumni in 157 countries around the world working to improve their communities and the lives of those in need.

This year marks the 24th year that the Evans School of Public Affairs at the University of Washington has participated in this prestigious program. We are one of 18 universities where Humphrey Fellows are placed. During the last two decades we have hosted more than 265 Fellows from 95 nations. Fellows undertake an individualized program of academic coursework, independent research, professional affiliations, field trips, special seminars, and consultations. They travel throughout the U.S. to attend professional meetings and colloquia, and to visit public and private agencies related to their professional fields.
